POSITION: School Psychologist

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To administer psychological and academic testing for the following: re-evaluations; diagnostic evaluations upon referral; intake evaluations; and courtesy evaluations.
- To prepare reports which include remediation techniques and sources of materials which can be used with the student to meet his special learning requirements and specifically indicate if the child is learning disabled according to the New York State definition.
- To interpret psychological findings to staff and parents.
- To participate in wrap-up meetings and CSE meetings regarding these evaluations when necessary.
- To serve as a member of the Evaluation Team for intakes and re-evaluations, the Student Study Team and PBIS team
- To serve as a member of the Mental Health Team to support students in need of emotional support.
- To work closely with teachers, support service faculty, and administrators to determine the best educational programs possible for RSD students.
- To provide small group or 1-1 counseling to students.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's Degree.
- New York State certification as a School Psychologist.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Strong background in language and academic development of deaf children and strong writing skills.
- At least 5 years' experience working with deaf students.
- Advanced Rating on the SLPI
